

# ENGLAND NETS COACH ROLE DESCRIPTION & SKILL REQUIREMENTS

#### Introduction

There are exciting opportunities to be part of a very special world Netball event and lead a team to world cup success.

In October 2015 four teams went to the Aged World Championships in Australia to represent England. The U18 ladies squad became World Champions, beating South Africa 51- 47 in the grand final! Following this in 2016, the ladies Nets team brought home another gold medal from the world indoor Netball championships in New Zealand.

This document looks to provide information for those interested in playing a part in this as well as clarifying the role description and the skills required.

#### Role Description – Head Coach (Volunteer) Pre-tour

- Lead the development and delivery of a coaching programme that prepares the relevant team for the World Cup event
- Manage and lead the team of Assistant Coach/Team Manager
- Develop and grow strong relationships within the squad and team
- Establish a motivating training environment
- · Lead individual player feedback and contribute to the development of the player and squad
- Assess and ensure that all players maintain a personal fitness & skill level suitable to train and compete as part of England Nets squads
- · Co-ordinate and lead planning meetings with Assistant Coach/Team Manager
- Work with selectors to select final touring squads
- Coach should conduct themselves in line with England Netball Coach Code of Conduct

#### On tour

- Work with Assistant Coach/Team Manager to make appropriate team selections during the World Cup event
- · Co-ordinate and lead daily meetings with Assistant Coach/Team Manager & Physio
- Establish and maintain a motivating pre-match environment
- Coach should conduct themselves in line with England Netball Coach Code of Conduct and the rules and stipulations of WINA and the tournament

#### Time commitment

- Anticipated 20 x UK based half-full day training sessions plus planning time
- Tour to South Africa during Autumn 2018 (likely to be approximately 2 week period).



# Role Description – Assistant Coach/Team Manager (Volunteer)

#### Pre-tour

- Support & lead elements of the delivery of a coaching programme that prepares the relevant team for the World Cup event
- Contribute to the facilitation of strong relationships within the squad and team
- Play a key role in the leadership team of the squad and ensure training sessions operationally run smoothly
- Maintain a positive, motivating and friendly training environment

#### On tour

- Work with the Head Coach to make appropriate team selections during the event
- Attend & contribute to daily meetings with the Head Coach & Physio
- Ensure high levels of off court pastoral style support is available and where needed issues shared with Head Coach & Physio
- · Ensure all match schedules, paperwork & equipment is available on all match days

#### Time commitment

- Anticipated 20 x UK based half-full day training sessions plus planning time
- Tour to South Africa during Autumn 2018 (likely to be approximately 2 week tour)
